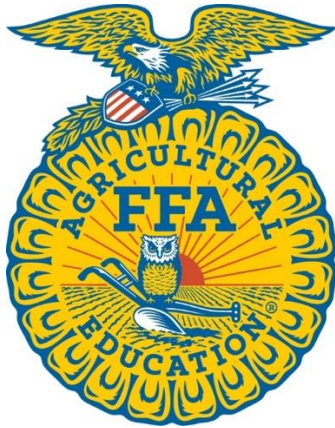

## America's Farmers Grow Ag Leaders Scholarships Presented by Bayer



**ELIGIBILITY:** High school senior or current college student pursuing any degree or certification in any AFNR Career Pathway. Applicants may also pursue non-agricultural majors in communications, sales, marketing, public relations, journalism, statistics, mathematics, engineering, bioinformatics, computer science, welding or diesel mechanics.

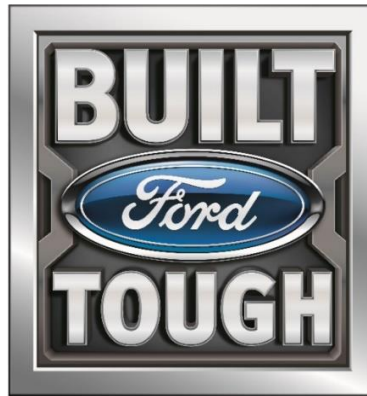

Applicants must demonstrate financial need, have participated in community service and reside in the state of Pennsylvania.

AWARD: Awards valued at \$1,000 each. Non-renewable.

SPONSOR BIO: Alvin F. Moyer, Jr. was a member of Future Farmers of America from 1945 to 1949 and served as the state president of FFA for Pennsylvania from 1948 to 1949.

## Arthur and Nell Lewis Memorial Scholarship – FFA Membership Required



ELIGIBILITY: High school senior or eligible college student pursuing a four-year degree in any area of agriculture. Attendance at the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, Virginia Polytechnic and State University, Blacksburg, Va., required. Applicant must have been a member of Virginia FFA for 2 years prior to enrolling in college and a resident of Virginia (preference given to applicants living in counties of Bland, Buchanan, Carroll, Dickenson, Floyd, Giles, Grayson, Lee, Montgomery, Patrick, Pulaski, Russell, Scott, Smyth, Tazewell, Washington, Wise, and Wythe, plus any independent cities located in those counties). Applicant must be planning to enroll in an on-campus four-year degree program administered by the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, Blacksburg, Virginia, or its successor. Minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale required. Award is renewable for three additional years.

AWARD: Awards valued at \$1,500 each. Non-renewable.

### **B.R.I.D.G.E. Endowment Scholarship – FFA Membership Required**



ELIGIBILITY: The B.R.I.D.G.E. Endowment Fund Scholarship is a \$5,000 scholarship for physically disabled or handicapped members of FFA who will be a college freshman in the fall, pursuing a 4-year degree in any of the following areas: Agricultural and Forestry Production (including Agronomy and Crop Science, Animal Science and Nutrition, Dairy Science, Equine Science, Farm and Ranch Management, Fishing and Fisheries Science, Forest Management, Horticulture, Landscape Architecture, Livestock Management, Nursery and Landscape Management, Plant Science, Poultry Science, Turf Management, General Ag Science, Wildlife Science, Ecotourism, Sustainable Agriculture); Agricultural Communication and Education; Agricultural Business and Economics; Agricultural Sales and Marketing; Agricultural Engineers, Scientists, and other related specialists; or Social Service Professionals (parks, rural sociology, and public service and administration in agriculture) Completion of the B.R.I.D.G.E. Endowment Fund Supplemental form is required to be considered for this scholarship.
